Admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science courses under NRI/NRI Sponsored Quota for the AY 2025-26

An applicant seeking admission under NRI/NRI sponsored quota shall submit an online application within the prescribed date. Non-Resident Indians staying abroad for a minimum period of one year (as on the last date for submission of the online application) can only sponsor a candidate for admission under the quota.

- An Indian Citizen who stays abroad for employment/carrying on business or vocation outside India or stays abroad under circumstances indicating an intention for an uncertain duration of stay abroad is a non-resident, (Indian Persons posted in U.N. Organisations and Officials deputed abroad by Central/State Governments and Public Sector undertakings on temporary assignments are also treated as non-residents). Non-resident international citizens of Indian Origin are treated on par with non-resident Indian citizens (NRI).
- An individual shall be treated as a Non-Resident in India in any previous year if he/she has not resided in India for:
 - ➤ At least 182 days in the year of admission, **OR**
 - ➤ At least 365 days during the 4 years preceding the year of admission **AND** at least 60 days in the year of admission.
- An individual who does not satisfy above mentioned conditions shall be treated as a **Resident Indian.**
- Indian citizens having NRI status shall sponsor their own siblings / any blood relatives supported by a passport / other relevant documents as proof for their support of nominations.
- If any seats are left over under the NRI category, the same shall be filled up with Indian Nationals having essential qualifications.

II. Eligibility:

Bi.P.C stream

The applicant must have passed 12th standard (English Medium) from an Indian Board or an equivalent Board outside the country with the subjects of Biological and Physical Sciences for admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota through Bi.P.C stream.

M.P.C stream

The applicant must have passed the 12th standard (English Medium) from an Indian Board or an equivalent Board outside the country with the subjects of Mathematics and Physical Sciences for admission into B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota through M.P.C stream.

III. Criteria for selection:

Bi.P.C stream

The selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared based on the marks secured in the Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent. In case of a tie, the marks in the optional subjects, viz., Biology/ (Botany, Zoology) followed by Physics and Chemistry, shall be taken into consideration, and in case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference.

M.P.C stream

The selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared based on the marks secured in Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent. In case of a tie, the marks in the optional subjects, viz., Mathematics, followed by Physics and Chemistry, shall be taken into consideration, and in case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration, and the older candidates shall be given preference.

IV. General Instructions for Bi.P.C. & M.P.C Stream courses:

A good knowledge of English is compulsory. A certificate of the candidate's proficiency in English issued by the respective Indian Mission abroad or recognized agencies should accompany their applications for admission.

The students seeking admission under the quota are not required to appear for any Entrance test(s) of the state or the country.

V. Age limit for Bi.P.C. & M.P.C Stream courses:

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years.

VI. Hostel facility:

Hostel facility shall be provided, subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.

VII. Fee structure for the admitted batch of AY 2025-26:

- A. US\$ 12000 as Institutional Economic Fee for the entire course (@ US\$ 3000 per annum)
 - All other Regular fees (UF & NUF), Hostel & Mess charges and others, if any, are additional.
 - The Institutional Economic Fee of US\$ 3000 payable in INR by the candidate at the time of admission shall be based on the exchange rate of prevailing Indian Rupees per dollar at the time of admission.
 - The fee payable during the subsequent academic years shall be based on the exchange rate of Indian Rupees per dollar prevailing on the date of registration as per the academic calendar issued by the University.
- **B.** If the leftover seats under NRI/NRI sponsored quota are filled up with Indian Nationals, the Institutional Economic fee shall be paid in Indian Rupees equivalent to **US\$ 1500 per semester** (Regular fees (UF+NUF), Hostel & Mess charges, and others, if any, are additional).

VIII. Documents to be submitted:

- 1. An undertaking by the candidate and parent on stamp paper (Rs. 100/- or equivalent currency), duly notarized (ANNEXURE-A).
- 2. An undertaking by the Sponsorer on stamp paper (Rs. 100/- or equivalent currency), duly notarized (ANNEXURE-B).
- 3. Birth Certificate/Proof of Date of Birth.
- 4. Higher Secondary (10+2) or Equivalent Examination Mark Sheet.
- 5. Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate issued by the Head of the Institute/University last attended (whichever is applicable).
- 6. Bonafide/Study Certificate issued by the Head of Institution last attended.
- 7. Physical Fitness Certificate.
- 8. Self-certification documents of the sponsorer showing the proof of NRI status.
- 9. Work Permit or Business Establishment, as applicable.
- 10. Valid Passport and Visa of the Financial Sponsor.
- 11. Bank statement showing the latest transaction of the previous 6 months.

IX. Other Important Information:

- Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
- The selected candidates under NRI/NRI Sponsored shall be treated on par with regular quota students. No special amenities or facilities shall be provided.
- The University shall not own the responsibility of the applicant's involvement in any unlawful activities during the period of study, and he/she is solely responsible and shall be required to appear for any enquiry from the police or any other competent authority.
- The candidates admitted under this quota are **not eligible for any reimbursement of fees or any other educational concessions offered by the Government**.
- Furnishing of any false information in the application shall result in cancellation of admission at any stage.

- All the rules and regulations governing UG programmes shall also apply to the candidates selected under the NRI/NRI Sponsored quota.
- Candidates shall have to attend for certificate verification at their own cost.
- The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for certificate verification does not automatically guarantee a seat.
- The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat <u>before the closure of admissions</u> process for the AY 2025-26, an amount of Rs. 10,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fee already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions <u>after the closure of the admission</u> process for the AY 2025-26, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fee (except the caution deposits). In addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 10,000/- as a processing fee.
- Professor Jayashankar Telangana Agricultural University (PJTAU) is the only Agricultural University in the State. The University has not accorded any affiliation to any private colleges in Telangana.
- The University is not responsible for the information provided on other websites.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and as such, they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTAU under any quota. All the seats shall be filled by the University only.
